## **IN MAY 2022 WE OFFICIALLY KICKED-OFF OUR “ 2 TEACH- 2 TOUCH” PROJECT IN BERLIN.**

The “2teach-2Touch” project, whose entire title is “To Teach Being a Citizen in a Waste Economy is To Touch Life”, is an innovative and very contemporary project. Its purpose is to involve citizens in the waste economy of their city and their society. To make them aware of important and decisive choices that can really have an impact on the environment on a global level.

In 2030 the EU aims at reducing the carbon emission of 50%; a first important step in the long way toward the 0-emissions of 2050.



Involving citizens in taking responsibility for their waste management...it sounds a bit ambitious. In the “2 Teach- 2 Touch” Project we think that the best way to involve citizens is education; therefore our project addresses mainly adults, who are lacking the necessary knowledge to change habits and make a difference.

The results of the project are a series of MOOCs meant to help adults learn about waste economy in general and some best household practices they can implement at home. These solutions came from all the partner countries, who researched about their inner habits and proposed alternatives to waste management to implement at home.

We already met twice; in Berlin for the Kick-off meeting, where we defined tasks and deadlines for our results, and in Mugla, where we checked on everybody’s work, determining then the next steps on the roadmap.

Now, The first module about “Participation in waste economy as a citizen” is ready. And we cannot be more excited. We are really proud to share and disseminate this knowledge to everyone on a European level...and what not? Also globally!

The modules are now available in English, but since we think that this topic really touches everybody on earth, soon they will be available in German, Italian, Spanish, Polish and Turkish.
